Hello Mr. Kramer,

Rockford School District #205 received your attached request for documents pursuant to the Illinois Freedom of Information Act. On May 27, 2015 I left you a message asking for a return call to clarify the documents you were seeking. I did not receive a response. I sent a follow-up email inquiry and did not receive a response. On May 29, 2015, Janice Hammer, Legal Department Executive Assistant, spoke to you to attempt to clarify your request. You told her you would clarify for her at a more convenient later date and time. To date we have not heard from you in response to our request you clarify the documents you are seeking in the attached request.

As such, while the District receives various types of contributions and donations, we do not maintain documents that describe many of these contributions/donations. To the extent you are asking for a record of the donations/contributions accepted by the Board pursuant to *Board Policy 4.34 Operational Services; Gifts and Bequests*, from January through May 26, 2015, there were none. To the extent you are seeking documents that describe in-kind contributions required in order for a community organization to obtain a waiver of a District facility rental fee, please see the attached Board of Education Executive Summary and attachment. If you are unable to access these online documents, please feel free to notify me and I will make the record available for inspection or copying. 5 ILCS 140/8.5 (b) Finally, if you would like to resubmit a request identifying the specific documents you are seeking, I will respond accordingly.

To the extent you consider this response a denial of your request, you have a right to have this response reviewed by the Public Access Counselor (PAC) at the Office of the Illinois Attorney General. 5 ILCS 140/9.5(a). You can file your Request for Review with the PAC by writing to:

You also have the right to seek judicial review of your denial by filing a lawsuit in the State circuit court. 5 ILCS 140/11. If you choose to file a Request for Review with the PAC, you must do so within 60 calendar days of the date of this denial letter. 5 ILCS 140/9.5(a). Please note that you must include a copy of your original FOIA request and this denial letter when filing a Request for Review with the PAC.
