Hello Ms. Wang,

You are hereby notified that your request for District records below is being treated as a voluminous request as defined in section 3.6 of the Illinois Freedom of Information Act. (5 ILCS 140./3.6). Your request is being treated as a voluminous request because:

- You have submitted more than 5 individual requests for more than 5 different categories of records or a combination of individual requests that total requests for more than 5 different categories of records in a period of 20 business days;
- Your request requires the compilation of more than 500 letter or legal-sized pages of public records unless a single requested record exceeds 500 pages.

Please be advised, you must respond to this notification within 10 business days specifying whether you would like to amend the request in such a way that the District will no longer treat the request as a voluminous request. If you do not respond within 10 business days or if the request continues to be a voluminous request following your response, the District will respond to the request and assess any fees pursuant to Section 6 of the Illinois Freedom of Information Act. (5 ILCS 140/6)

You will be provided an initial response to your request 5 business days after receipt of your response to this notification or 5 business days from the last day for you to amend the request, whichever is sooner. The District may request an additional 10 business days to comply with the request.

You have the right to have the District's determination that this is a voluminous request reviewed by the Public Access Counselor (PAC) at the Office of the Illinois Attorney General. 5 ILCS 140/9.5(a). You can file your Request for Review with the PAC by writing to:
