



## **CAPA at Auburn High School**

**Auditions:** Dates and times are posted on the CAPA Page of the RPS205 Website. Auditions take place at Auburn High School. Students and parents/guardians: Please plan on arriving 15 minutes early for check-in.

### **High School Audition Requirements**

- 1) Completed CAPA Audition Registration Online.
- 2) Requirements needed for audition as listed below.

**High school** students can choose the specific area(s) in which they audition. Students previously enrolled in Auburn CAPA classes must audition to enroll in a new area if adding or changing pathways.

**VISUAL ART** – Bring a portfolio of original artwork (at least five samples of previous work.) You will be required to draw a still life during the audition. You will be interviewed about your experiences and interest in visual arts.

**DANCE** – Wear dance attire or loose-fitting workout clothes with dance shoes or socks. Be ready to follow demonstrated dance styles and to participate in creative improvisational activities. You will be interviewed about your experiences and interest in dance.

**MEDIA PRODUCTION** – If you have samples of past computer, video work, bring in DVD format or flash drive. Audition will be in the form of an interview.

**MUSIC** – Piano – Bring a selection to perform (bring two copies of sheet music: one for you and one for the instructor). You will be asked to sight-read and play the C, G and F scales in the octaves from memory.

**MUSIC** – Strings – Bring your instrument and a prepared piece to perform. A variety of instruments are available for those who do not own personal instruments, but prior arrangements must be made. You will be asked to sight-read and play the D and G scales.

**MUSIC** – Winds/Percussion – Bring your instrument and a prepared piece to perform. A variety of instruments are available for those who do not own personal instruments, but prior arrangements must be made. You will be asked to sight-read and play the B-flat and E-flat concert scales.

**MUSIC** – Chorus – Prepare two pieces in contrasting styles to perform a cappella. You will be asked to sight-read, vocalize, match pitch, sing scales and perform tonal memory exercises.

**THEATRE** – Acting – Prepare (memorize) a play, poem or prose selection of approximately two minutes in length. Bring a copy of the piece to the audition. You will be interviewed about your experience and interest in theatre.

**THEATRE** – Technical Theatre – Bring sketches, photos and/or artwork that represent what you have done in the area of technical theatre. You will be interviewed about your experience and interest in technical theatre.
