



CAPA at West Middle School

Auditions:

Audition dates, times and location are listed on the RPS205 website on the CAPA page.

Students and parents/guardians: Please plan to arrive 15 minutes early for check-in.

Audition Recruitments for students entering 6th-8th grade:

- 1) Completed CAPA Audition Registration online.
- 2) Requirements needed for audition as listed below.

Middle school students must audition for ALL of the following areas:

ART – Bring a few pieces of original artwork. Do not bring traced or copied work. You may bring works from school or created outside of school. You will be asked to draw a still life during the audition.

DANCE – Wear clothing that will allow your body to move freely. You will be asked to do a few simple dance sequences and participate in creative and improvisational activities.

MUSIC – Vocal – Prepare a piece to perform a cappella. You will be asked to match pitch and sing scales.

MUSIC – Instrumental – If you play an instrument, bring it and a short piece of music. Be prepared to perform. You will be interviewed about your experience and interest in instrumental music.

THEATRE – Memorize a one to two minute monologue. If you don't have a piece, one will be given to you. You may also be asked to perform simple exercises in the areas of characterization, direction, and projection.

TECH THEATRE – Bring sketches, photos and/or artwork that represent what you have done in the area of technical theatre. You will be interviewed about your experience and be asked to go through some design elements.
