Please ensure you are picking your child up on time. Please do not forget to bring in an ID. We will ID everyone the first time they are picking up and they must be on your child's pick up list.

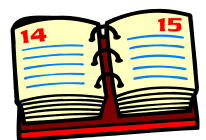
