



Eisenhower Middle School Uniform Policy

Students must dress in a manner which is consistent with rules of the Eisenhower Uniform Policy. Style of dress must not interfere with the educational process and be in good taste, as evaluated by the administration. Students dressing inappropriately will be sent home or a parent will be asked to come to school with a change of clothes. Students may be placed in ALE room until proper dress arrives.



6th, 7th, & 8th Grade Dress Code:

1. Uniform shirt colors-only solid white, gold/ yellow, or black collared shirts. No grey. Logos on shirts must be small in size.
2. Shirts worn under uniform must also follow dress code.
3. Pants/ Bottoms khaki (ONLY). To be worn at waist.
4. NO JEANS, LEGGINGS, JEGGINGS, FLANNELS OR PAJAMAS, ETC.
5. Eisenhower Spirit Wear may be worn any day, including hoodies. Tight fitting clothing will not be permitted.
6. NO SANDALS (including flip flops, athletic sandals, slippers, etc.)
7. A belt is required in the original policy where appropriate.



The following items are inappropriate for school and not allowed.

- ANY SHIRTS (INCLUDING UNDERSHIRTS) THAT ARE NOT WHITE, YELLOW/GOLD, OR BLACK
- Gang identifiable symbols, guns, and drug/alcohol symbols
- Clothing must adequately cover a student's private area and under garments.
- Tops not covering torso or belt line (low cut from or back) are not permitted.
- Shirts with sleeves torn off, large holes or rips in them, tank tops
- Jackets - a jacket is defined as outerwear used to protect the student from the elements – outside layer that a student would wear to school in cold weather. No nylon zippered tops are allowed. No Hoods.
- Hats, scarves that cover the entire head, bandanas, hoodies, sunglasses, picks, combs in hair
- CD players, mp3 players, iPod, electronic games, communication devices, cell phones, or laser pointers
- Clothing with holes to excess or underwear exposed
- No clothing or jewelry (including wallet chains) items that may be potentially harmful

UNIFORM VIOLATION POLICY

Students found to be out of uniform will remain out of class until proper uniform is in place. Parent will be contacted to provide a uniform in a timely manner, the student must comply with administrative recommendation (including alternative uniform if available). Students who cannot or will not comply with the uniform code will receive consequences according to the Student Code of Conduct.

Clothing will not be lent to students because of stains or because they are cold. Please be sure students bring appropriate sweaters/sweatshirts for these purpose or keep them available in their lockers.

IDs are considered part of the school uniform and must be worn at all times. Students can purchase a lanyard for \$5.00 or a clip for \$1.00. There is must be worn so it is visible by staff at all times and above the waist. Students who deface or lose their IDs will have to replace it for \$5.00.

**ANY ITEMS CONFISCATED BY STAFF MUST BE PICKED UP BY A PARENT.
They will not be returned to students.**

We know that we can count on your support to provide the best possible atmosphere for your child's education. If students are in doubt about whether or not their clothing choice will be acceptable, they should check with an administrator in advance and/or bring a change of clothes. This will prevent them from being sent home to change. Final say as to acceptable clothing will be at the discretion of the administration.
