Dear Parents,

Thank you for talking to your children about their chatting with the friends when they should be working or transitioning between subjects. They have really improved on taking a shorter time to transition from one activity to the other. They still need to work on completing school work before they talk to their friends. There also is a problem with a few students who do complete their work and then start talking to the friend that has not completed his/her work.

In reading we continue to work on character development. The reading groups are each reading books at their own levels and practicing using these skills in their text at their level. In math we have been working on place value and rounding to the nearest ten and hundred. We will begin working on addition and subtraction using three and four digits. In writing we are beginning opinion/argument/persuasive writing. We will work on this through Christmas.

Our plans for the field trip to the Nutcracker on December 6th are almost finalized. Please remember that we are encouraging the children to wear theater clothes. Theater clothes are much like clothes one would wear to a fancy dinner or to Church/Mosque/Temple/Synagogue. Dresses for the girls, suits, button-down shirts, sweaters, ties, dress pants, and dress shoes are all appropriate concert clothes. If your children do not have the aforementioned, please do not feel obligated to purchase new clothes. We will bring all children regardless of what they are wearing, but we would like to encourage the whole concert experience when we go to the Coronado.

I talked with the symphony asking them if we could have extra seats for the performance of the Nutcracker. We may bring extra parent chaperones on the trip, however, they will need to drive themselves to the theater because the buses are packed.
