About these databases:

If the database name is followed by the phrase “IP-authenticated”, you will not need to log in to the site at school but you will need to log in when using the site from home. If the phrase “not IP-authenticated” is used, then you will always need to log in to the site.

Current Biography Illustrated (not IP-authenticated)

For biographical information on important people during the Holocaust and WWII, search for info in this database, which contains more than 15,000 full text biographies with photographs; searchable by name, profession, title, place of origin, gender, race/ethnicity, and more.

Encyclopedia Britannica Online School Edition K-12 (IP-authenticated)

Grade level-appropriate reference articles, journals, and magazines, content-appropriate websites, multimedia, and curriculum content.
