UNIFORM POLICY

UNIFORM & DRESS CODE POLICY

The **uniform policy is mandatory for all Kennedy students** as carefully outlined below. **All students are** required to wear uniforms daily.

If students come to school out of uniform, parents will be contacted 1st hour to bring appropriate clothing. <u>Students will not be allowed in their regular classes until they are in uniform.</u> Students are allowed to wear grade level colored polos, spirit wear, and hoodies Monday- Friday. NO logos, writing, and extra colors are allowed. Hoodies must be plain or have the correct color with the KMS team name on them (Hoods are not allowed on head in the building). On Friday's, students will be allowed to dress in other Kennedy spirit wear such as black hoodies, team jerseys, team warm-ups, or carnival shirts.

- 1. ID All students must wear their own school issued photo ID and grade level colored lanyards ONLY. Defaced ID'S AND lanyards must be replaced for a fee.
- 2. SHIRTS Classic polo shirts with collar; solid (no patterns or logos). The following are the colors for each grade: Navy Blue for 6th grade, Baby/Powder Blue for 7th grade, and Heather Gray for 8th grade. Shirts will be available for purchase at registration and during the school year. Grade level spirit wear can be worn every day.
- 3. **SWEATSHIRTS** -Solid or patterned colored (with no writing or logos) May be worn <u>under</u> uniform polo.
- **4. CARDIGANS/BUTTON DOWN SWEATERS Solid grade level uniform color** may be worn over the uniform shirt (collars outside).
- **5. UNDERSHIRTS** Solid or patterned colored (no writing or logos)
- **6. PANTS** -Uniform pants should be **khaki** and worn at the waist in an unaltered fashion. No folding, tucking, pinning, tying, or banding pant legs in any manner. **Absolutely no jeans, sweat pants/joggers, jeggings or leggings.**
- **7. SHORTS/CAPRIS/SKIRTS/JUMPERS** -All should be **khaki** in color. All should be at least knee length. No basketball or sports shorts permitted. Leggings (solid or patterned) may be worn under shorts, capris, skirts, and jumpers.
- **8. SHOES** Low heeled shoes are permitted. NO FLIP-FLPS, BEDROOM SLIPPERS OR BEDROOM BOOTS, SANDALS, OPEN-TOED SHOES, OR HIGH HEELS. No shoes with wheels.
- 9. BELTS No large belt buckles. Belts must be worn through belt loops and around the waist at all times.
 - No coats or jackets may be worn in the classroom at any time
 - Caps, armbands, sweatbands, do rags are not allowed. Anything that covers the entire head is not permitted
 - No sunglasses are to be worn in the school
 - No rattail combs; no combs or picks of any kind may be worn in the hair or sticking out of pockets as this is unsafe
 - No stickers on body or uniforms. No marking or drawing on body or uniforms
 - We suggest students do not have facial jewelry. Students with facial jewelry wear this at their own risk. Any jewelry worn by a student is worn at their own risk
 - Anything considered by the administration to be a distraction to the learning environment will not be allowed in school
 - Students will be expected to call home for proper uniform at any time during the day if their uniform is out of compliance
